

Privacy Policy

This website and related subdomains are provided by the Escambia County Sheriff's Office (ECSO) as a public service. Be advised that information you submit to the ECSO via this website may be considered a public record under the laws of the State of Florida and may be subject to disclosure pursuant to a Public Records Request.

Information Collected

If you visit our site(s) to read or download information, we automatically collect and store the following information about your visit:

1. The name of the domain (for example, "xcompany.com" if you use a private Internet access account or "yourschool.edu" if you are connecting from a university's domain) and IP address (a number that is automatically assigned to your computer when you are using the Internet) from which you access our website.
2. The type of browser and operating system used to access our site.
3. The date and time you access our site.
4. The Internet address of the website from which you linked directly to our site.
5. The pages you visit on our site.

We may set and access "cookies" on your computer which often includes an anonymous unique identifier that is sent to your browser from a web site's computer and stored on your computer's hard drive.
